Food Pantry/ Clothing/ Sanitation:

Food and clothing pantries are down this month as we needed to close the first two weeks because of the holiday and restocking. Reunion Church is gathering supplies for us for January.

Bucket:

The bucket helped **7** cases with some form of finance assistance or direct help from our resources.

Camp Camby Families:

We are now up to **13** individuals, veterans, and families in need living at the camp. We had various heating, plumbing, and water issues in December or we would have been able to take more families into the camp. These families are ongoing and receive food, housing, and clothes and are not included in our above numbers.

Community meals:

We were able to start community meals this past week. We will have meals every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for these families. We had 15 show up this past Tuesday for a meal and orientation. It was a great night!
